### **1. Literature Review:**

Is literature synthesized? Does it create a compelling argument?

Is the rationale for the H/RQ clear and persuasive?

### **2. Methods:**

How strong is the fit between the method and the RQ/H (variables are clearly present, tested etc.)?

### **3. Results**

Do the results clearly address/answer the H/RQ? Is there enough information to draw conclusions without offering interpretation of the results (that is for the Discussion section)?

### **4. Discussion (if present)**

Does the discussion clearly interpret the findings without overstating any inferences? Does it tie back to the RQ/H and the earlier literature? Does it include limitations and implications? Does it stress the insights gained by the study?
