Regional Fair Schedule	
Friday, March 2	
4:00 – 5:30 PM	<b>EARLY DISPLAY SET-UP AND INSPECTION</b> for those who prefer to set up displays on Friday night instead of Saturday morning. We encourage Friday setup as it is less stressful for the student.
Saturday, March 3	
7:45 – 8:30 AM	Student arrival for those who need to complete display set-up & inspection. If display was set-up & inspected on Friday, the student does not need to arrive until 8:40 AM
8:45 AM	ALL students seated at their display and parents proceed to seated locations
8:50 – 9:00 AM	Opening welcome to parents and students: International Ballroom: 4th and 5th Grade; Walb Classic Ballroom: 6th-12th grade.
9:00 – Break	<b>Judging: Round One</b> Judges & participants only allowed in display area. During this phase of judging, the grade (elementary), category (junior/senior) and special award judges visit as many student displays as possible before a mid-morning break.
10:30 – 10:50 AM (approximately)	Morning break – Students may visit with parents, restroom, get a snack but must stay in close vicinity for being called back to their display location. A time to return will be announced.
11:00 – Noon	Judging: Round Two Judging continues as needed for students not yet released. ALL REMAINING CHILDREN WILL BE RELEASED BY NOON.
12:00—12:30  ALL 4 <sup>TH</sup> & 5 <sup>TH</sup> GRADE DISPLAYS  REMOVED BY 12:30	PUBLIC DISPLAY AND DISPLAY REMOVAL: Parents and students may visit displays from noon to 12:30. The 4th and 5th grade displays <u>must be removed</u> no later than 12:30. This will be the only public display time for projects. 6th-12th grade displays should remain in the Classic Ballroom until right before the award ceremony for judges to re-visit during their final deliberations. PARENTS OR OTHER ADULTS IN CHARGE MUST BE THERE TO RETRIEVE THEIR CHILD BY NOON AS THERE IS NO SUPERVISION AVAILABLE.
